#WeNeedYouNow resonated with the community. With an enhanced sense of urgency as children no longer had access to safety nets during the shutdown, together we were able to succeed in our mission even through the uncertainty brought on by COVID-19.

Our community found ways to stay connected with our community to spread awareness, as well as find creative yet effective ways to continue to ensure the children of Cenla were getting the help they needed.

Champions for children responded to the call for advocates and made the choice to join our mission to be a

voice for all children! 25 new advocates completed our virtual training during the Spring! A virtual curriculum & volunteer training method was implemented during the shutdown to enable our new volunteers to prepare for their journey as a child's voice while keeping health and safety top priority. Staff and Volunteers found new ways to virtually stay connected and let our community know that our efforts to advocate for children and families did not stop!


