The mission of Children's Advocacy Network is to help heal and champion abused and neglected children throughout Central Louisiana. We strive to accomplish this by providing comprehensive services to children and their non-offending caregivers through our three programs: **CAC** (Children's Advocacy Center), **CASA** (Court Appointed Special Advocates), and **Therapy**.
