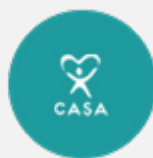




Children's Advocacy Network

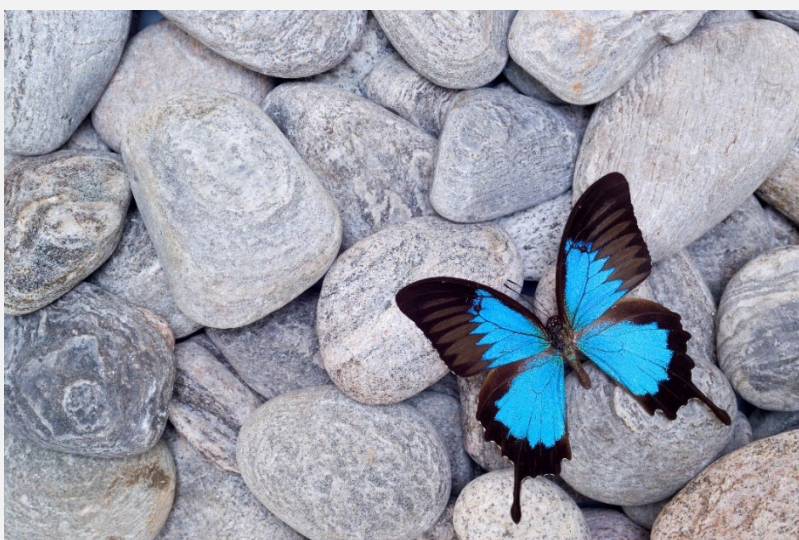
Total Children Served by our Programs in 2024 – 1390

Races of All Children Served:

- Native American/Alaskan Native: 3 (<1%)
- Asian: 8 (<1%)
- African American: 493 (34.6%)
- Hispanic/Latino: 26 (1.8%)
- Caucasian: 798 (57.4%)
- Other: 13 (1%)
- Multiple Races: 49 (3.5%)

Gender of All Children Served:

- Male: 577 (41.5%)
- Female: 813 (58.5%)



Ages of All Children Served:

- 0-12 years: 953 (68.5%)
- 13-17 years: 424 (30.5%)
- 18+ years: 13 (1%)

CAC (Children’s Advocacy Center) *By The Numbers.....*

- Children Served – 569
- Forensic Interviews Conducted – 565
- Confirmed Child Trafficking Victims Served – 28
 - 38 additional children were suspected of being trafficked or at-high-risk for trafficking
- Children Trained in Child Abuse/Trafficking Prevention & Awareness – 196

CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocates) *By The Numbers.....*

- Children Served – 822
- Active Volunteers – 149
- Hours Worked by Volunteer Advocates – 3,254
- Miles Traveled by Volunteer Advocates – 16,783
- In-service Volunteer Advocate Training Hours – 636
